## MSU Trustee Candidate Justin Johnson Calls for Engler's Resignation or Removal

*Callous comments are a continuing liability as school tries to reconcile with survivors and begin the next stage of reforms*

**GREENVILLE** — Justin Johnson, Democratic candidate for the MSU Board of Trustees, on Friday called for Interim President John Engler to step down immediately or be removed by the Board of Trustees. On Thursday, additional emails were released in which Engler disparaged Rachael Denhollander and other survivors.

"John Engler has continuously revealed himself to be a callous, uncaring, and incredibly petty man," Johnson said. "Retaining him as interim president has no benefit, and only serves to darken the clouds hanging over the reputation of the school."

Johnson is a business owner who says he can't understand why the Board of Trustees is willing to let their employee continue to serve despite mounting calls for his resignation after the release of multiple emails in which Engler attacked survivors.

"No healing can be done by Engler. His words speak for themselves, and members of the board must act now and remove him to restore any shred of trust in the administration of Michigan State University."
